Triangle Tech's Mandatory Fees are as follows:

Registration Fee- \$75.00 total – a minimal payment to hold the student's seat prior to starting classes, which is applied to the total tuition.

Consumable Fees – fees charged prior to the start of each semester for consumable materials used during enrollment in the program:

<u>CADD with Additive Manufacturing & 3D Printing Technology (CADAM)</u> - \$75.00/semester - \$300.00 total — examples of consumables may include, but are not limited to; large format plotter ink and printer ink, vellum, 8-1/2" x 11" copy paper, 3D printing ABS (Acrylonitrile Butadiene Styrene) plastic filaments, and **Isopropyl alcohol (IPA)** cleaning materials used to clean resin, remove support material, and clean print bed trays.

<u>Maintenance Electricity & Construction Technology (ME)</u> - \$100.00/semester - \$400.00 total – examples of consumables include, but are not limited to; electrical wire, phone and data wire, conduit, screws, cable and data connectors, receptacles, switches, fuses, lights, etc.

<u>Carpentry and Construction Technology (CARP)</u> - \$325.00/semester - \$1,300.00 total — examples of consumables include, but are not limited to; wood, drywall, drywall compound, concrete, brick, block, grout, sand, lime, molding, ceiling tile, roofing materials, copper & PVC pipe, paint, primer, sand paper, nails, screws, ear plugs, dusk masks, etc.

Refrigeration, Heating, Ventilation & Air Conditioning Technology (RHVAC) - \$100.00/semester - \$400.00 total - examples of consumables include, but are not limited to; refrigerant, sheet metal, acetylene, propane, electrical wire, leak detector, copper tubing, flair nuts and plugs, etc.

Welding and Fabrication Technology (WELD) - \$325.00/semester - \$1,300.00 total - examples of consumables include, but are not limited to; welding electrodes, welding gases, structural steel shapes, pipe, steel plate, grinding wheels, resin & flap discs, saw blades, nozzles, contact tips, ear plugs, N-95 masks, etc.

Activities Fees -A nominal fee of \$5.00 charged prior to the start of each semester that is applied to various costs incurred for on and off campus activities.

Technology Fees – A nominal fee of \$50.00 charged prior to the start of each semester that is applied for use of technology equipment, resources, and Internet services.

Degree Fee - \$25.00 – fee paid for the printing and mailing of the student's diploma to Triangle Tech from a 3^{rd} party vendor. The degree fee is paid prior to the start of the 4^{th} semester.

Parking Fees

Triangle Tech, Greensburg School -

Limited off-site parking by permit is available for a nominal monthly charge, payable one semester in advance. The total monthly charge is \$16.00 or \$64.00 per semester. Those desiring not to obtain a permit may park on off-site street areas.

Certification Fees

For students enrolled in the <u>Refrigeration, Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning Technology program</u>, - \$15 fee (payable in total in the second semester) is applied to cover the cost of the Light Commercial Refrigeration portion of the HVAC Excellence Employment Ready Exams by ESCO * - \$60 fee (payable in total in the third semester) is applied to cover the cost of the Air Conditioning Exam, Gas Heat Exam, and the Heat Pump Exam portion of the HVAC Excellence Employment Ready Exams by ESCO*. - \$25 fee (payable in total in the 4th semester) is applied to cover the cost of the EPA Refrigerant Recovery Certification exam*.

For students enrolled in the <u>Welding and Fabrication Technology program</u>, a \$240.00 fee (payable in total in the third semester) is applied to cover the cost of the A.W.S. D1.1 Welding Certification Test*; a \$200.00 fee (payable in total in the fourth semester) is applied to cover the A.S.M.E. 6-G Welding Certification Test*; and a \$240.00 fee (payable in total in the fourth semester) is applied to cover the cost of the of the API 1104 Welding Certification Test*.
